Lady Jacket Profile:

Amy Zehr makes transition from net to hardwood

Cedarville College senior Amy Zehr has quietly established herself as one of the finest Lady Jacket athletes ever to perform in not one, but two sports. After leading Cedarville to a 33-13 record and an NAIA District 22 runner-up finish in volleyball, she quickly made the adjustment to basketball.

In volleyball, Zehr holds 13 school records including all of Cedarville's marks for kills and blocks in a match, season, and career -- all set in just three seasons. She was named to the All-NAIA District 22, NCCAA District III, and Mid-Ohio Conference teams, plus led each with 5.55 kills per game.

"Amy is the most outstanding athlete I've ever coached," quipped Cedarville volleyball coach Elaine Brown. "The fact she set her records in only three seasons is remarkable."

Zehr, along with freshman point guard Melissa Hartman, missed the basketball season opener at Malone because they were playing in the NAIA District 22 volleyball tournament. Three nights later, both were on the hardwood at Georgetown, KY and Zehr responded with 21 points and 15 rebounds.

She enters tonight's game averaging 22.3 points and 13.5 rebounds per game while shooting 57 percent from the field. She was named the MVP at the Wilmington Tournament over the weekend after totalling 50 points and 31 rebounds in the two games.

"I expect Amy to have her best year yet," claims Lady Jacket basketball coach Kathy Freese. "She is a tough competitor and very talented, plus we look to her for a lot of leadership."

Zehr recently became the sixth player in Cedarville women's basketball history to surpass 1,000 career points. She has already moved up to fourth on the Lady Jackets all-time scoring list with 1,064 points. She currently has 726 career rebounds and is on track to pass the current school record of 951.

Zehr's 336 rebounds last year was a new school mark for a season when her 11.2 average ranked 19th nationally in NAIA Division II. She

was named to the NCCAA All-America Second Team and to the All-Mid-Ohio Conference Second Team. She also holds two other school records for most points scored in one game (41) and for most steals in a game (8).

Amy is an elementary education major and is the daughter of Mr. Joseph Zehr and Mrs. Janet Haigh, both of Fort Wayne, Indiana.

TONIGHT'S OPPONENT -- Notre Dame College is a school of 900 students located in South Euclid, Ohio near Cleveland. The Blue Falcons, who are 1-1 on the season, are members of NAIA Division II. Tonight's meeting is the first ever between the two schools in basketball.

NEXT GAME -- The Lady Jackets have Thanksgiving weekend off before returning to action next Tuesday. They travel to the College of Mount St. Joseph to face the Lions, who are pre-season ranked #8 in NAIA Division II and the defending District 22 champions.
