IV. Individual Records: Overall Play in 1984 and comparison of play from 1983 to 1984

MIKE REED

1. Lowered his average from 82.9 to 79.3 (lowest for 1984 and also most improved).
2. Bird ratio (-1) stayed almost the same as 1983.
3. Par ratio (0) increased significantly from 7.7 in 1983 to 9.8 in 1984 (best on the team).
4. Bogey ratio (+1) lowered from 7.0 to 5.6 (lowest on the team).
5. Lowered Doubles (plus) ratio from 2.2 to 1.6.
6. Was Overall Medalist (T) in one match, Team Medalist in the Tiffin Invitational, and in the NAIA District 22 Tournament.
7. Made All-MOC, All-NCCAA, and All-NAIA District 22 teams.

TOM EWING

1. Lowered his scoring average from 81.2 in 1983 to 79.4 in 1984 (second lowest on the team).
2. Showed a small increase in Bird ratio from 1.1 to 1.2.
3. Par ratio increased significantly from 7.6 to 9.2.
4. Lowered Bogey ratio from 8.0 to 6.3.
5. Ratio of Doubles (plus) stayed approximately the same.
6. Was Team Medalist (T) in one match, Team Medalist in the Xavier Invitational, and Malone Invitational, Overall Medalist in the Bluffton Invitational, and (T) for the low round in the NAIA District 22 Tournament.
7. Made All-MOC, All-NCCAA, and All-NAIA District 22 Teams.

JOHN GREENWOOD

1. Lowered his scoring average from 82.1 to 80.3.
2. Showed a drop in the ratio of (-1 and - 2) from 1.4 to 1.0.
3. Par ratio increased from 7.1 to 9.2.
4. Bogey ratio decreased from 7.3 to 6.2

5. Doubles (plus) ratio decreased from 2.1 to 1.6.
6. Was Team Medalist in MOC match (Arrowhead).
7. Missed making All-MOC by one stroke.

BOB FIRES

1. Lowered his scoring average from 82.3 to 80.3.
2. Bird ratio slightly improved from 0.7 to 0.9.
3. Par ratio increased slightly from 8.1 to 8.5.
4. Bogey ratio increased slightly from 7.1 to 7.6.
5. Decreased Doubles (plus) ratio considerably from 2.0 to 1.0 (lowest on the team).
6. Was Team Medalist (T) in one match.
7. Missed making ALL-MOC by one stroke

TOM GREVE

1. Lowered his season average from 83.1 to 81.2.
2. Increased Bird ratio from 0.7 to 1.4 (highest on the team).
3. Par and Bogey ratio remained approximately the same (7.5 and 7.45 respectively).
4. Doubles (plus) ratio lowered from 2.3 to 1.6.
5. Was Overall Medalist at the Cedarville Invitational and at one other match.
6. Shot the two lowest rounds on the season (72 & 73).
