Format for Play:

- 1. Two day 36 hole tournament-score best 4 out of 5 on each 18. In case of tie-the teams contending will begin on #1 tee and play a sudden death scoring best 4 out of 5.
- 2. Course conditions- It will be the tournament directors responsibility with the assistance of the club professional to determine conditions of play. It is recommended the conditions be announced the day before the tournament incorder for teams to practice under the tournament format.
- 3. U.S.G.A. rules will apply special course rules will be explained prior to play by golf pro.
- 4. Two stroke penalty for throwing clubs.
- 5. Everyone will score for another in the threesome. Report scores to the official scorer at the completion of each round. Check cards carefully. Scorer and player sign card and hand in to official scorer. Failure to have both signatures means disqualification.
- 6. No smoking and/or drinking by participants on the course.
- 7. Slow play will be penalized-keep moving. If a threesome should create a gap of 2 holes or more they will be penalized 2 stroke each. Rules committee will be checking on these gaps.
- 8. Out of bounds are clearly designated by white stakes. All out of bounds are penalized by stroke and distance.
- 9. If you have any question concerning a rule interpretation please play a provisional ball and get a ruling when you get back to the clubhouse. Do not hold up play for an interpretation.
- The "All District #22 Team" will include the top 5 players recording the lowest 36 hole score.
- 11. No coach or participant will be permitted on the course prior to tee-off time on the day of the tourney.
- 12. Teams are restricted to either one practice round or one tournament round prior to the day of NALA Dist. #22 Tournament competition.
