Subject: NAIA Basketball National Player-of-the-Week Selection #6

KANSAS CITY, MO--Austin Calhoun of Langston University OK (District 9), who set a District scoring record with a 60-point performance against Philander-Smith AR, is the NAIA national player-of-the-week for games played February 1-7.

The 6-5 junior forward from Pritchard, La., tallied 121 points (40.3 average) during his three-game week, shot 70 per cent from the field (49-70), 77 percent from the freethrow line (23-30) and added 38 rebounds (12.7 average).

Calhoun connected on 24 of 35 field goal attempts and added 12 free throws in Langston's 115-114 overtime victory against Philander-Smith. Earlier in the week he tallied 38 points in a 98-97 overtime loss to Bishop and followed with a 23-point outing in a victory over Arkansas Baptist.
