Subject: NIAA Basketball National Player-of-the-Week Selection #4

KANSAS CITY, MO--Danny Lewis of Belhaven College HS (District 30), who led his team to three victories, is the NIAA national player-of-the-week for games played January 18-24.

The 6-2 senior forward from Florence, MS put together games of 31 (73-60 win over Millsaps), 32 (71-68 victory over Auburn-Montgomery) and 29 points (62-49 win over Spring Hill) as the Clansmen climbed over the .500 mark for the season.

In addition to his 92 points (33.7 average), Lewis connected on 36 of 50 field goal attempts (72 percent), including a 12-14 performance against Auburn-Montgomery. He was 20-26 from the free throw line, pulled down 24 rebounds and added six steals and three assists during the week.
