CEDARVILLE REMAINS PERFECT

After three MOC contests the Cedarville College Yellow Jackets are the only team with a perfect MOC record. The Jackets were lead last week by Eric Mounts who had games of 32 and 34 points in leading the Jackets over Ohio Dominican and Mount Vernon Nazarene. In hot pursuit of the Jackets are Urbana, Malone, Rio Grande, and Walsh, all at 2-1. Key contests on Tuesday are Cedarville at Walsh and Malone at Urbana. On Saturday Urbana hosts Cedarville and Walsh hosts Malone in the annual Mayor's Cup game in Canton.

Ron Wilczak was instrumental in leading Malone to two victories last week. The 6'5" senior from Lorain scored a total of 56 points, collected 25 rebounds, and added 8 assists. Dave Potopsky (Walsh) does not seem to be hampered too much by a sprained ankle as he scored a total of 43 points, pulled down 15 rebounds, and handed out 8 assists in leading the Cavaliers past Tiffin and Rio Grande. Despite two losses last week the Ohio Dominican Panthers received a solid effort from Mike Stritholt. Stritholt scored 34 points and collected 17 rebounds.

At this point it is hard to say who will win the MOC, but it does appear that any one of 6 teams could win the title.
