## **"Walsh University Wins Second Straight NAIA Men's Great Lakes Region Tennis Championship"**

(Canton, OH/Hall of Fame Courts) For the second straight year Walsh University has won the Great Lakes Regional Tournament and will compete in the NAIA National Championships in Tulsa, Oklahoma (5/18-23)

Walsh's doubles combination of Ryan Contini and Matt Titchner won the doubles title with a 6-4, 6-2 win over Haris Faruqui and Shariq Faruqui of Findlay. In the singles final, Transylvania's Austin Polston defeated Haris Faruqui in the tie breaker to win the singles crown and advance to the NAIA National Championships as an individual.
