



#### **Tonight's Game**

The Cedarville University women's basketball team hosts the Ursuline College Arrows tonight in the Callan Athletic Center. Cedarville, ranked #2 in the Preseason NAIA Division II poll is off to a 2-0 start after capturing the Cedarville Invitational this past weekend. The Lady Jackets defeated Madonna 85-67 before nipping NAIA #5 Indiana Wesleyan 71-70 in the title game. This will be the first action of the 2004-05 campaign for Ursuline – members of the American Mideast Conference's North Division.

Four of CU's top five scorers return from last year's NAIA Division II National Tournament runner-up team. The quartet includes two-time NAIA All-American and AMC Player of the Year Kari Flunker, AMC South Division Freshman of the Year Brittany Smart, All-AMC First Team post player Emily Delimpo, and point guard Karah Walton, who joined Smart on the All-AMC South Division Freshmen Team.

Flunker, a senior guard, led the nation in three-point field goal shooting in 2003-04 and paced the Lady Jackets in scoring with 17.4 points per game. She was the squad's top free throw shooter (.774) and was the fourth-leading rebounder with 4.9 boards per game. Smart returns after a successful rookie campaign. She was the Lady Jacket's second-leading scorer at 15.1 points per game while pacing the club with 88 steals. Delimpo, a 6-0 junior, hauled in 9.1 rebounds per game last year while adding 12.4 points per game.



game last year while adding 12.4 points per game. Sophomore Walton contributed 7.6 points, 3 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game.

Kari Flunker

Senior leadership will be a key for success as Head Coach Kirk Martin looks to Flunker, Tami Gheen and Crystal Stuckey for steady play. Classmate Kylee Teboda returns to the team after sitting out last season. Sophomores Kristi Beougher, who will be counted on under the boards, and Stacie Travis, who provides backcourt depth, should also make key contributions.

Three newcomers join the ranks of the Lady Jackets and Martin will be watching for their continued development. Rookie guard Julie McQueen and freshman post player Mary Stockdale both have potential to contribute. Crystal Wiley, a junior transfer from Geneva College, gives added strength to the rebounding corps.


After the first two games, Brittany Smart leads the Lady Jackets in scoring with 18 points per game with Kari Flunker close behind at 17 points per contest. The only other player in double figures is Karah Walton – adding 11 points and 3 rebounds to the squad. Four CU players are tied for the team lead in rebounding – Smart, Emily Delimpo, Kristi Beougher and Crystal Stuckey – are grabbing 4.5 boards per game.

Cedarville leads the all-time series with the Arrows by a 2-0 margin including a 92-50 victory last December at Ursuline.

### Last Time Out

The NAIA Division II No. 2 Lady Jackets used a late-game rally to escape No. 5 Indiana Wesleyan, 71-70, in the championship game of the Cedarville Invitational on Saturday. It was CU's 26th straight victory in the Callan Athletic Center.

The Wildcats, who drilled 10-of-21 three-pointers, hit back-toback treys for a 68-63 lead with 2:10 left. However, Kari Flunker responded with a three-pointer and two free throws to tie the game at 68-68 at the 1:15 mark. IWU scored which was followed by Flunker making one-of-two free throws with 40 seconds left for a 70-69 Wildcat margin. The visitors turned the ball over and Brittany Smart made what would be the game-winning jumper in the lane with 23 seconds left. Indiana Wesleyan missed two jumped shots and the front end of a one-and-one free throw situation in the final seconds that could have won the game.

Smart tallied a team-high 20 points while Flunker finished with 15 points. Tournament MVP Karah Walton finished with 11 points and five assists while Kristi Beougher chipped in 10 points.

#### **Looking Ahead**

The Lady Jackets play in the Huntington Invitational this weekend. Cedarville faces St. Joseph's (IN) at 8 pm on Friday and will square with either Huntington (IN) or Trinity Christian (IL) at 1 or 3 pm on Saturday. The squad returns home to face Taylor University (IN) in a non-conference contest one week from tonight at 7 pm.




