KANSAS CITY, MO--Norfolk State's David Pope, who led the nationally-ranked Spartans to three victories last week, is the NAIA national player-of-the-week for games played January 4-10.

The 6-8 freshman forward from Newport News, VA, scored 69 points, pulled down 36 rebounds and shot 65 percent (34-52) from the floor in Norfolk's victories over Livingstone NC (105-79), Morgan State MD (78-70) and St. Augustine's NC (80-69).

Pope, a high school all-American, has been one of the major reasons why Norfolk State (District 19) has a 10-1 record and is ranked among the top five NAIA schools in the country.
