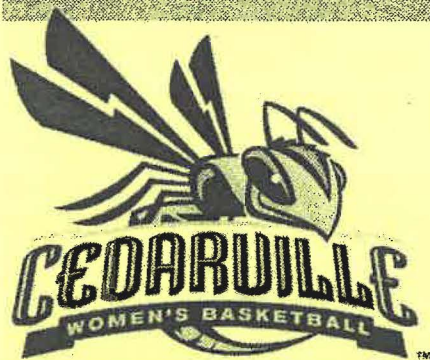

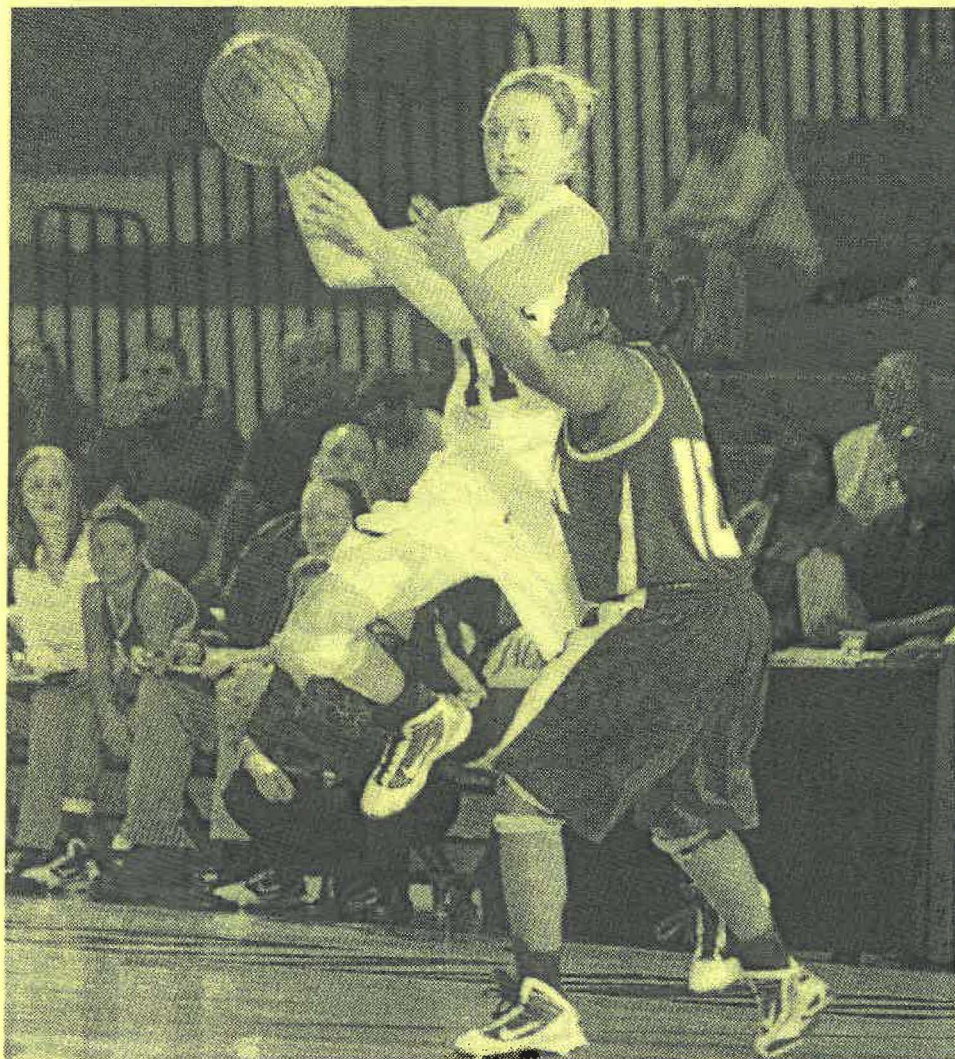

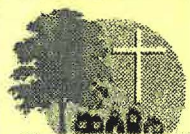

Tonight's game

The Cedarville University Lady Jackets host the Notre Dame College Falcons tonight in the Callan Athletic Center as part of the annual Alumni Weekend.

Cedarville, ranked #3 in this week's NAIA II Top 25 Poll and winners of 13 straight, enters the contest with a record of 21-3 overall including 12-1 in the AMC after defeating host Wilberforce on Tuesday by a score of 97-69. Notre Dame comes to town with a 14-8 overall record (10-4 AMC) including a 73-54 decision at Malone on Tuesday night.

The Lady Jackets lineup features three players scoring in double figures. Leading the offensive attack is reigning AMC Player of the Week Alison Lemon. The 5-7 senior guard paces CU in scoring, assists and steals. Lemon is third in the AMC with 5 assists per game and is in the league's Top Ten in scoring, FT %, three-point FG % and steals.

Junior forward Aubrey Siemon adds 14.4 points per game and is the squad's leading rebounder with 12.7 boards per contest. Siemon, who leads the AMC in rebounding, has posted 16 double-doubles in CU's 24 games this year. She is third in the league in FG % and fourth in FT %.

Junior guard Lydia Miller is averaging 11 points per game while hitting .434 from the field. She is Cedarville's third-leading rebounder at 5 per game and is fourth in assists with 49.

Junior Caitlyn Brooks, coming off a career-high 18 points at Wilberforce, is contributing 8.9 points per game while shooting a team-best .540 from the field. The 6-1 forward is fourth in rebounding at 4.2 boards per game.

Rachel Hurley, a 5-4 junior guard, has recorded 59 assists while tossing in 8.1 points per game. She is 32-of-34 from the charity stripe this season for an impressive .941 mark.

Kara Cayton, a sophomore guard, adds 7.6 points per contest and is tied with Alison Lemon with a team-high 42 three-point field goals. She has recorded a second-best 64 assists.

CU is shooting .445 from the field including 146-of-416 attempts from the three-point line for a .351 mark. The team continues to do well at the free throw line with a league-leading .770.

Cedarville is outscoring opponents by 15.5 points per game. The Lady Jackets are controlling the boards with a +6.1 margin.

Junior Yvette Hunter is Notre Dame's second-leading scorer at 11.9 ppg while topping the Falcons in rebounding at 6.5 boards per game. The 5-10 center is four points shy of becoming the ninth NDC player to reach 1,000 career points.

Classmate Kealy McNally is the Falcons' leader in offensive production with 12 ppg while hitting a team-best 32 three-point field goals.

Chelsea Andorka, a 5-8 rookie guard, adds 9.8 points per game while leading the Falcons in assists (56) and steals (49).

Freshman guard Tracy Payne is 30-of-35 at the charity stripe. NDC scores 73.3 points per game while allowing 66.7. The Falcons are hitting .406 from the field including .314 from behind the arc. Notre Dame is solid at the free throw line with a .739 effort. The squad is dead even with opponents in the rebounding category.

CU leads the all-time series with Notre Dame by a 7-1 margin. The Lady Jackets registered a 90-63 win last February 7 in a contest played in South Euclid, Ohio.

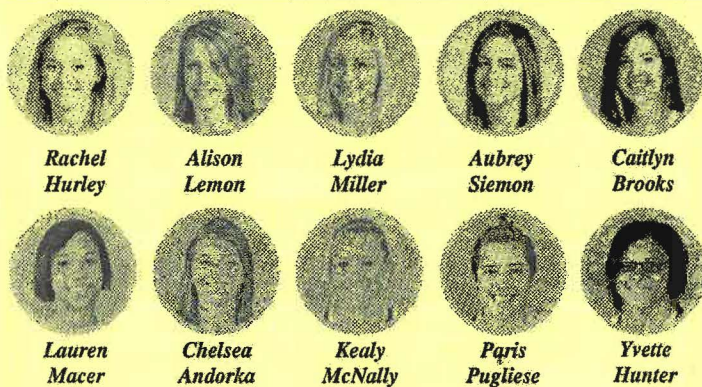

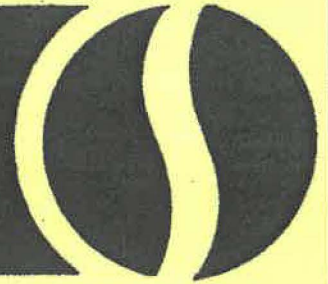

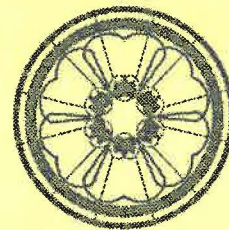

Last Time Out



Aubrey Simon racked up 21 points and 14 rebounds as NAIA Division II #3 Cedarville extended its winning streak to 13 straight with a 97-69 American Mideast Conference victory at Wilberforce. A 23-8 flourish to finish the first half resulted in a 54-29 margin by the break. The Yellow Jackets, 21-3 overall and 12-1 AMC, took the spread out to as much as 37 points in the second period by shooting 65 percent from the floor over the final 20 minutes.

Simon posted her 16th double-double of the season. She has pulled down 10 or more rebounds in every contest of the team's 13-game winning streak.

Caitlyn Brooks maneuvered for a career-high 18 points. Alison Lemon totaled 15 points, seven assists, and five steals while Lydia Miller added 13 points.

All ten players in uniform scored for Cedarville. The visitors shot 56 percent from the field and outrebounded Wilberforce, 41-34. The Bulldogs dropped to 5-17 and 3-12 AMC.

Cedarville travels to Pepper Pike, Ohio on Tues., Feb. 9 for an American Mideast Conference matchup with the Ursuline College Arrows. The contest is slated for a 7:00 p.m. tipoff.

The Lady Jackets return home for three straight AMC games beginning on Thurs., Feb. 11 when NAIA #8 Shawnee State comes to town for a critical league contest. CU hosts Mount Vernon Nazarene one week from tonight, Sat., Feb. 13 as part of Li'l Sibs Weekend. Northwestern Ohio visits on Tuesday, Feb. 16.

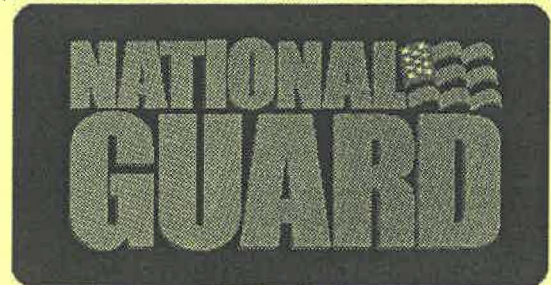

Allison Lemon returns for her final season with the CU women's basketball program.....will again serve as one of three captains in 2009-10.....started all 30 contests last winter.....led team in scoring at 15.6 points per game.....posted team-bests in assists (139), steals (72) and three-point FG's (72).....hit .490 from behind the arc - third-best all-time at CU for a single season.... averaged 5.4 rebounds per game.....produced a season-high
