Subject: NAIA Basketball National Player-of-the-Week Selection #3

KANSAS CITY, MO--Johnson C. Smith University's NC (District 26) Phil Flores, who led the Golden Bulls to three victories including a triumph over nationally-ranked Norfolk State VA, is the NAIA national player-of-the-week for games played January 11-17.

The 6-3 junior guard from Houston, TX scored 80 points in three games, shot 63 percent from the field (31-49), 90 percent from the free throw line (18-20), handed out 26 assists and pulled off 16 steals.

In the Golden Bulls' 87-84 victory over Elizabeth City State NC Flores tallied 25 points and had eight assists; in their 93-90 victory over Norfolk State he scored 26 points and added nine assists and completed the week with 29 points and nine assists in JC Smith's 125-110 victory over Livingstone NC.
