Student Pharmacists Up for National Award

CEDARVILLE, OHIO -- Cedarville University's Student National Pharmaceutical Association (SNPhA) chapter has been selected as a finalist for the National Chapter Excellence Award. The final phase of the competition will be held at the SNPhA National Convention in Charlotte, North Carolina, July 27-30.

Cedarville is competing nationally in the medium-sized chapter division, for chapters with 50 to 99 members. The competition is assessed by how many points the chapter earns through various in- and out-of-school activities. Cedarville is currently ranked first in Ohio and third of 96 overall in SNPhA by points earned.

At the national convention, Cedarville students will present a brief pitch to try and earn the top ranking within their category.

"Cedarville's chapter is only two and a half years old, yet we are in the top five chapters. This shows that we live out our motto of serving the underserved," commented chapter president Ankit Pandav, a fourth-year pharmacy student. "We serve, give back to the community and are intentional about showing God's love in our interactions with patients."
