President of Delhi Bible Institute Speaks in Chapel

CEDARVILLE, OHIO -- Isaac Shaw, national director and president of Delhi Bible Institute, will speak in chapel at Cedarville University on Tuesday, Sept. 10, and Wednesday, Sept. 11. Chapel begins at 10 a.m. and is open to the public.

Delhi Bible Institute, located in New Delhi, the capital city of India, has discipled more than 4,000 students and pastors and has planted more than 2,000 churches throughout northern India.

Living in one of the most unreached parts of the world, Shaw has been a leader of several Christian movements and continues to be at the forefront of standing with the persecuted church in India.

Shaw is also the senior pastor of Bible Bhavan Christian Fellowship, which now meets in more than 60 locations in seven states in India. Under his leadership, Bible Bhavan has planted 110 churches.

Shaw has authored five books in the Hindi language, and his team has published 50 Bible commentaries and tools in Hindi.

Shaw graduated with a Bachelor of Arts and a Master of Arts in English literature from Delhi University.

He and his wife, Gloria Ojeda, have four children: Gloria Raquel, Myriam Elizabeth, Sarah and Isaac. Both Sarah and Isaac currently attend Cedarville University, and Gloria and Myriam are alumni.
