Campus Visits Go Virtual

CEDARVILLE, OHIO -- Cedarville University's students shifted to all-online classes several weeks ago. Now, high school students who are thinking of attending Cedarville have an online option too. Beginning Wednesday, April 1, the private, Baptist university in southwest Ohio will offer virtual campus visits.

Virtual visits are available Monday, Wednesday and Friday at 10:30 a.m. and can be scheduled at cedarville.edu/visit. "To still provide information for students and families, we've launched the live virtual visit.
