## Triathlete Magazine Promotes #TeamUSA with Grace Norman on Cover of Olympic Edition

**CEDARVILLE, OHIO** -- While Grace Norman is training for the 2021 Paralympics in Tokyo, Japan, *Triathlete Magazine* is promoting the USA olympic program through the two most prominent triathletes for #TeamUSA--Morgan Pearson in the Olympics and Norman, a Paralympic gold medalist. The magazine is currently available and it features stories on Norman and Pearson, both who appear on the magazine's cover.

Norman has been primarily training in South Bend, Indiana with her coach Greg Mueller. As the Paralympics approach, she will use different geographic regions in the United States to hone her triathlon abilities with the hope of claiming a second gold medal at the 2021 Paralympics in Tokyo, Japan. The 2020 Cedarville University alumna, Norman is the reigning 2016 Paralympic Gold Medalist in the PT4 Triathlon in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. At 18 years of age, she was the youngest athlete in the field and the first to win the women's gold medal in the paratriathlon, as the sport debuted at the Games in Rio.

The games will be held August 24 to September 5.

Norman graduated from Cedarville with a bachelor's degree in nursing. As a collegiate athlete, she is a National Christian College Athletic Association (NCCAA) All-American, and a member of the Great Midwest Athletic Conference All-Academic team in 2017-18. As a freshman, she earned a spot on the all-freshman team in track and field.
