Preferred Partnership With Answers in Genesis Employees

CEDARVILLE, OHIO -- A new preferred partnership program that will provide discounts to Answers in Genesis employees for educational programs at Cedarville University began in January 2023. The program continues efforts by Cedarville University to provide higher educational opportunities for employees working in Christian ministries.

The new preferred partnership provides tuition discounts or scholarships to AiG employees and their families who enroll in graduate, undergraduate, or high school dual enrollment programs.

"We are thrilled to partner with Answers in Genesis," said Thomas White, Cedarville University president. "There are very few institutions that believe in a six-day literal creation and contend for a biblical worldview beginning in Genesis as we both do. This partnership will further our shared mission for excellent education rooted in God's Word."

This partnership comes after a long-standing relationship between Cedarville and AiG.

Dr. Georgia Purdom '94, vice president of education content at AiG stated, "As a Cedarville alum, I'm thrilled to see this partnership become a reality. This is a fantastic opportunity for our staff and children to receive the quality education that Cedarville offers. What a blessing to see like-minded Christian organizations team up to benefit each other."

Graduate Programs:

The preferred partnership program will benefit all AiG employees who are interested in pursuing an online or ministry graduate degree at Cedarville. All qualified candidates for admission will receive a 25% tuition discount for Cedarville's online graduate programs or the residential M.Div. program.

Undergraduate Programs:

Children of AiG employees are eligible to apply for and receive preferred consideration for the President's Ministry Impact Scholarship, which ranges from \$1,000 to \$7,000 per year. This scholarship can be used in addition to other forms of aid for which the student may qualify.

Additionally, high school or college students who work at AiG will qualify for a one-time \$500 scholarship during their first year as a Cedarville University student.

Dual Enrollment Program:

High school students who seek to get a jumpstart on their college experience receive an 80% discount for all classes through Cedarville's dual enrollment program. AiG employees who reside in Ohio may also benefit from College Credit Plus funding to enroll in Cedarville courses.

Located in southwest Ohio, Cedarville University is an accredited, Christ-centered, Baptist institution with an enrollment of 5,082 undergraduate, graduate, and dual-enrolled high school students in more than 175 areas of study.
