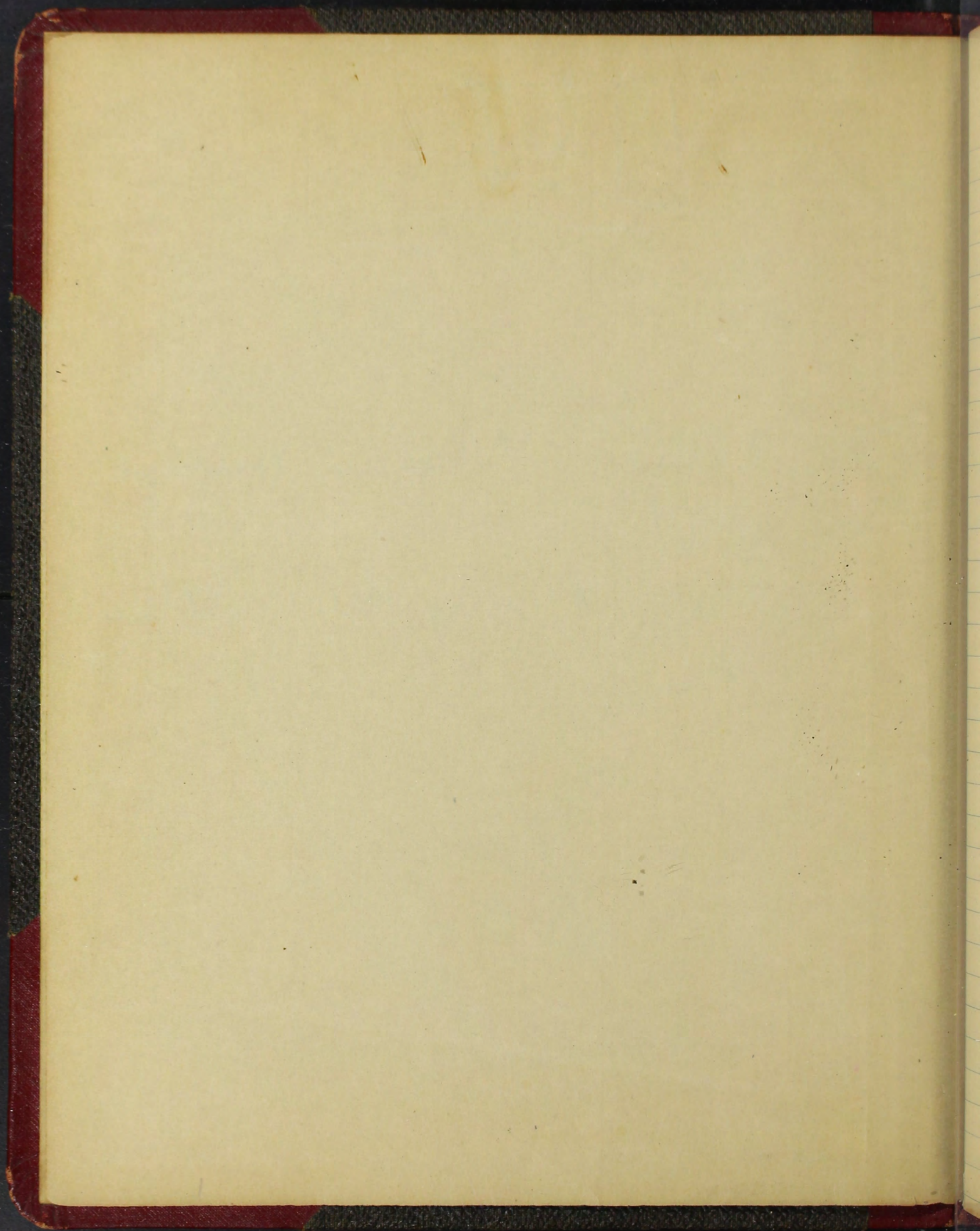

ty. 3 ladies came in to keep warm
they were here from 2:30 to seven had
to stand for many from Edamville to
fix it. I served them lunch. Clayton

took Anabel home.

Jan 3. Mon.

Children off to school. Raulain went in Ford truck washing Forest feeding till noon. Harry + Lotta Owens out for dinner. Clayton, Mary M. and I at Harmonians to covered dish supper. Mary + Beren classes. Raulain out coasting.

Jan 4. Tues.

Children at school. Forest feeding till noon. Clayton busy about stock. Clayton + Raulain at Xena after school. Called on Finney at hospital. Clayton at school board meeting.

Jan 5 Wed.

Children at school. Clayton feeding. Forest at crosses but then Clayton at church in afternoon. Help get supper. Mary sewing. All at Mason study at church.

Jan 6. Thurs.

Children at school. I busy about my work. Clayton feeding. Forest husking truck here for alfalfa hay for M. W. L. Clements. Edgar Little here for sheep and to see about helper. Raulain at Mrs. Son in evening about geometry. Rest at home.

Jan 7. Fri.

Clayton feeding Forrest husking
I busy sweeping up stairs. at 2:30 to
club meeting in afternoon. Clayton at
Grain meeting. At church in evening

Jan 8. Sat.

Helin here helping. we busy
balancing Fred came in on morning train
Collin Macmillan out for dinner. Clayton
and children at church service
then on to Syria. Clayton at supper
in evening Forrest feeding. Raulson at
Clifton to have feed ground. Fred left
on evening train.

Jan 9. Sat.

all at S.S. and church. Anabel
came home with us. Rob Salbreath
called. Raulson at supper to C.E. church
Clayton & Anabel at church. Mary Margaret
and I at home

Jan 10. Mon.

Cold winter morning. Found
five milk cows sick with milk fever
fresh day before. Dr. Anderson out.
Doctoring her. Forrest & Clayton feeding
Edgar took Clayton & Forrest to Rober
Horse sale. Clayton. Jany. Left came
out from town with Raulson. all
at home in evening.

Jan 11. Tues. Children at school. Jim here. Forrest & Clayton feeding till noon. Clayton Jim & I at Mary Williams to dinner with Constance for Collier McMillan. I went over to library to help Advisory Ladies make catalog. Jim & Clayton went to Springfield. I went to Anabel's got home about 7. Had supper. Children here at home.

Jan 12. Wed. Children at school. Forrest helping until noon with feeding. Jim and I busy about work all at Mrs. study and supper and lecturing course. Exhausted sick with cold at Dr. Marsh.

Jan 13. Thurs. Children at school. Cards helping with work. Cleaned chicken house. Jim here. I went to town to covered dish dinner at Mrs. Marsh. 7/4th Grange Club serving for doll to Jim Clayton, Anabel Jim & Forrest at 10 to horse sale. Mary Margaret & I at Anabel for supper. Men came down in evening. Raining in afternoon.

Jan 14. Fri. Children at school. I busy sweeping down stairs. Jim helping. I went to Mrs. Stevensons to Rock party. Clayton Jim at dinner. Clayton & Anabel feed Forrest & duty. Colder & faster. Raining at

Rice basket-ball game. Very cold.

Jan 15. Sat.

Cold blustering day zero this morning. Clayton & Forrest helped feeding till noon. Raydon in bus about. Clayton & Jim at town in afternoon. Clayton went to see Mr. Alexander. Anabel came home with them. A cold day.

Jan 16. Sat.

All but Jim at S. S. and Church. Anabel here. at Church in evening.

Mon Jan 17.

Children at school. Thru about work. Jim & I peeling apples making apple butter. Forrest helping fed. till noon. Clayton, Jim & Mrs. Harrison and I at Springfield. Clayton at town in evening. Maudie Williams called. Thawing today.

Jan 18. Tues.

Children at school. Clayton & Forrest feeding. Clayton at town on errand for forenoon. Jim & I thru about. Colder frost up. Snowed some in night, and snowed hard all morning. Raining in afternoon. Clayton at home to call and at town in afternoon.

Jan 19. Wed.

Children at school. Thru about work. Jim helping chury up back porch. Clayton at Columbus with Maudie Williams.

all day. Forrest feeding. A heavy rain, raining off and on all day. Creels way up. Runtel stopped and said sheep in Rinner field were up down sheep so Forrest and Jim went down and got them up on dry spot. All at supper at Church and Mission study.

Thurs Jan 28.

Children didn't have school on account of something wrong with servers. A damp dark gloomy day raining Creels way up. Clayton Runkins feeding. Clayton at Finney Runkins at town after butchering outfit for Finney. Finney sweeping up stairs. Parson May here for dinner. Clayton & Jim at town in evening.

Fri Jan 29.

Children at home. Jim helps Finney sweeping down stairs. Forrest helping Finney butchery. Clayton & Runkins feeding Runkins at town in afternoon with feet had hair cut. Harold Walters home with him for supper. All at town in evening but Jim, Children & Clayton at Back Ball game and at Mrs Horney's Creels party. School board meeting after game. Children, But & Mary Margaret stayed all night at Oxl as it was so late before meeting was in. Raining all day and very foggy and

damp. Couldn't get car started. So Kriebel came and took us to town. Maurer Williams brought us home.

Sat Jan 22.

Forrest at Finleys finishing up butchering Clayton & Rauland feeding Rauland took call to town in morning at Clifton mill in afternoon with feed to ground. I busy about Clayton & Jim at home in afternoon and evening.

Sat Jan 23.

Rain during night and froze over everything a glare. ~~of ice~~ so I didn't try to go to church. I wasn't feeling well in bed till noon came down for dinner on couch rest of day. A cloudy damp day rained some then ^{unfrozen} freeze over. Jim here.

Mon Jan 24.

Jim here helping. I up about some. Children at school. Forrest and Clayton feeding. Jim and Clayton and also Mary Margaret at Xenia. Mary had hair cut Clayton got his clothes at Kadoys. Anabel came out with them for supper. Clayton took her home.

Tues Jan 25.

Jim and I busy about work children at school. Forrest here in forenoon helping with feeding Clayton busy about Clayton helping Edgar with taking her to Hitchcock.

Wed. Jan 26.

Children at school Jim and I busy about work. Forest and Clayton feeding. All at the last Mission Supper and study. Then went to Opera House to see "The Man Nobody knows".

Thurs. Jan 27.

Children at home as sewer was not working right. I busy sweep Raulsin and Clayton doing chores. Raulsin at home hawking feed for I at church serving supper & supplies. Clayton and Jim at Spring Clayton at school board meeting. Took meat to some friends.

Fri. Jan 28

Jim about. Children at home busy. Making apple butter churning etc. Forest & Clayton sorting apples. Raulsin busy helping with the all at home that evening.

Sat Jan 29.

Helen here helping Jim about. Men busy with chores. Clayton, Jim, Rachel, Mrs. Creed & Kate and I at Session in afternoon. Jim left on train for Springfield. All home in evening. Rachel here.

Sab. Jan 30.

all at S-S and church

Anabel here. at Church in evening

Mon. Jan 31.

Children at school. I busy about the work. Forrest husking. Clayton feeding all at home in the evening

Tues Feb 1.

Children at school. I busy about work. Forrest husking. Clayton moving hog boxes and feeding.

Wed Feb 2.

Children at school. I busy about work in forenoon. Clayton feeding and moving hog boxes and bringing logs up to house to treat for lice. Clayton brought lubricating oil into house and put in stove to heat. and went in out to barn left it to long and it boiled over or exploded and set kitchen afire the men saw a blue smoke in yard and came rushing to house and with neighbors help and chemicals put it out before much was burnt, but the lower floor to hall was badly smoked. The road was lined with autos and many here to see fire. I was at turn where it happened but when I got the word drove out home was glad to find house not burnt up.

Thurs Feb 3.

all up at early hour but things looked like a stormy night this morning, didn't know which way to turn. we sent word to insurance people and they came out after dinner and made their adjustments after they left. Forrest Clay by and started to clean up kitchen and by night had fire in kitchen going floor scrubbed up and things looked some better.

Ira called and wanted us to come for dinner but we couldn't leave. Mr and Mrs Harman came out in the morning ready to help us clean up.

Fri. Feb 4.

Children at school. Forrest and Ralph pulled paper in dining room and washed paint and got it so it was clean. also pulled paper in kitchen & washed paint and had every thing cleaned up by 4 o'clock. Raulsey at basket ball game.

Helen here, all busy about work. Forrest busking clay by & Raulsey feeding. At 7 o'clock in afternoon brought wall paper for dining room at 8 o'clock for supper.

stop fixing radiators. All busy about
work.
