CEDARVILLE, OHIO -- Hamilton native Rob Moore, a senior at Cedarville College in Ohio, earned All-America status at the NAIA Indoor National Track Meet on Feb. 27-28 in Kansas City. He placed third in the finals of the mile run in a time of 4:14.57. It marked the second time in three years that Moore has grabbed a spot on the indoor All-America unit. He also placed third in the mile in 1985.

"It was a good run for Rob," said Cedarville coach Elvin King. "He was looking real good halfway through the race when he unfortunately got boxed in and couldn't get out. He eventually had to come from the eighth position and made it as far as third. I think he could have challenged for the lead, but he had too much ground to make up. He finished two seconds behind the winner."

Moore reached the finals by placing second in his heat in a time of 4:18.0. Rob is also a two-time NAIA outdoor All-American in the 1500 meters and will complete his collegiate running career this spring.

"We are expecting Rob to have an exceptional outdoor season," remarked King. "He has had an outstanding career and I know that there are some things he wants to accomplish yet in the outdoor campaign."

Rob, a 1983 graduate of Allendale Public High School, is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Monty Moore of Hamilton.
