Its mission is to publish both academic and non-academic monographs consistent with the goal of the Digital Commons to preserve, organize, provide access to, and disseminate the scholarly, creative, and intellectual work of Cedarville University.

Though not an official university press, the work of Cedrus Press is authorized by Cedarville University and thus submissions for publication must be in harmony with the mission and doctrinal statements of the university. Before acceptance for publication, all submissions are subject to a review process. Publication by the Press does not represent the endorsement of the University unless specified otherwise. The opinions of and sentiments expressed by the authors of books published by Cedrus Press may not reflect the views of DigitalCommons@Cedarville, the Centennial Library, or Cedarville University and its employees. Individual authors are solely responsible for the content of their work.

## Benefits of Publishing with Cedrus Press

Cedrus Press is interested in publishing works by scholars affiliated with Cedarville University and by others who are working in research areas of significant interest to the university or the local community. The imprint helps foster Cedarville University's commitment to the future of scholarly communications.

Cedrus Press provides an innovative way for faculty and others to promote and disseminate their research with the following benefits.

**Public Access:** Full texts of works may be published online in an open-access format, available free to users worldwide.

**Readership:** Cedrus Press can support projects for any size readership. It aims to give a platform for scholars whose works might not meet the financial requirements for publication by a traditional press.

**Publishing Schedule:** The process of manuscript review from acceptance to publication is significantly quicker than that of a traditional press.

**Print-on-Demand:** Titles may be made available as print-on-demand publications. Titles may be printed singly or in lots as readers place orders. No hard copy run is printed by Cedrus Press and, therefore, there are never any remainders.

**Style:** Cedrus Press may provide assistance with editing, design, and composition (typesetting) for works in a variety of sizes and formats. In consideration of any assistance that Cedrus Press may provide, a portion of the earnings from print versions will be negotiated to support Cedrus Press operations.

**Processing Charges:** Cedrus Press does not levy any author processing charges for online versions.

**Analytics:** The Digital Commons is indexed by Google and Google Scholar and can provide download statistics to authors.

**Copyright:** Authors retain ownership of all rights to the work.

**ISBNs:** All new works are assigned International Standard Book Numbers [prefix: 978-0-99672-] for both electronic and printed editions.

**Cataloging:** Catalog records for Cedrus Press are available via OCLC.

**Preservation:** Permanent access to materials is ensured through the repository.

## Review Process for Submissions

Before acceptance for publication, all submissions are subject to a multi-level review process. All submissions must be complete manuscripts; i.e., Cedrus Press will not consider monographs that are preliminary proposals. The manuscript will first be reviewed by the Digital Commons staff, who will make an initial judgment as to its appropriateness for Cedrus Press and review technical aspects such as grammar, layout, etc. Should there be content questions, additional experts may be engaged to review the manuscript. A final review will be completed by university administration including the President or his designee. Approval at all review levels is required in order to proceed with publication. Works published by Cedrus Press not endorsed by the University may not include logos nor the seal of the University and must include disclaimers of endorsement.
